

Birmingham Unit Base Support Ltd reduces its Energy Costs by £19,000 per year and carbon savings of 25 tonnes per year.



Background

Birmingham Unit Base Support (BUBS) Ltd provides a range of support services to the TV and Film Industry. Like most business sectors the media production industry is keen to embed sustainability into its operations. Productions can demonstrate their sustainability credentials by achieving the Albert sustainable standard. One key requirement of the Albert award is for productions to demonstrate progress in reducing their carbon footprint. BUBS aims to be at the forefront in helping its clients reduce the impact they have on the environment.

The Project

The company purchased three dual fuel generators which can run on LPG. On LPG the generators produce fewer carbon dioxide emissions than when using petrol.

In addition, the company achieved approved sustainable supplier status for production industry. Low Carbon SMEs developed BUBS environmental policy which allowed the company to become an Albert award approved supplier and win more production contracts.
